

Islamic Military Counterterrorism Coalition Receives a Delegation of Journalists from Various Saudi Media Organizations



Maj. Gen. Mohammed bin Saeed Al-Moghedi, IMCTC Secretary-General, received on Tuesday, Feb. 18, 2020 a delegation of reporters representing various Saudi media organizations.

Over the course of the meeting, the visiting delegation was provided with an overview on IMCTC's approach in countering terrorism through joint efforts and initiatives on its four core counterterrorism domains of action (ideology, communications, terrorism financing and military). All these efforts aim to deepen cooperation and coordination among IMCTC member countries.
