

IMCTC Participates in Riyadh International Humanitarian Forum

The Islamic Military Counter-Terrorism Coalition (IMCTC) took part on Monday, February 20, 2023, in the third Riyadh International Humanitarian Forum (RIHF3). The event, organized by the King Salman Humanitarian Aid and Relief Center (KSrelief), is held under the patronage of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, King Salman bin Abdulaziz, and was attended by HRH Prince Faisal bin Farhan, Governor of Riyadh Region, as well as other prominent humanitarian leaders, donors, practitioners, and researchers.

The IMCTC participated actively in the Forum with an introductory pavilion in the accompanying exhibition to highlight its most important efforts across its four counterterrorism domains: ideology, communications, counter-terrorist financing, and military.
