

IMCTC Receives the Defense Minister of the Republic of Cameroon

The Secretary-General of the Islamic Military Counter Terrorism Coalition, Maj. Gen. Mohammed Saeed Al-Moghedi received at IMCTC headquarters, Tuesday 18/07/2023, His Excellency, the Defense Minister of the Republic of Cameroon and the accompanying delegation.

The Defense Minister and the accompanying delegation received a briefing on IMCTC's mission, objectives, strategic initiatives and coordination of the efforts of the Coalition's Member States for the eradication of terrorism. The briefing also covered IMCTC's role in countering extremist ideology, terrorist tendencies through the ideology, communications, counter terrorist financing and military initiatives.
