

ISLAMIC MILITARY COUNTER TERRORISM COALITION (IMCTC) LAUNCHES THE ANNUAL PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES FOR 2021

Within the framework of programs and activities implemented by the Islamic Military Counter Terrorism Coalition (IMCTC), the IMCTC Secretary-General, Maj. Gen.
