A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON JOINT COOPERATION SIGNED BETWEEN ISLAMIC MILITARY COUNTER TERRORISM COALITION (IMCTC) AND THE FINANCIAL ACADEMY

Within the framework of cooperation between the Islamic Military Counter Terrorism Coalition (IMCTC) and Arab, Islamic and international organizations and centers, a memorandum of understanding on joint cooperation was signed today, on Monday, 14 December 2020, between IMCTC, represented by the IMCTC Secretary-General, Maj.
