

IMCTC Secretary-General Receives the Military Attaché of the Arab Republic of Egypt

The Secretary-General of the Islamic Military Counter-terrorism Coalition, Maj. Gen. Mohammed bin Saeed Al-Moghedi, received on Thursday, December 30, 2021, HE, Brig. Gen. Mohammed Naji Yousef, the Military Attaché of the Arab Republic of Egypt to Saudi Arabia.
