

The Chief of the General Staff of the Kuwaiti army receives IMCTC Secretary-General

The Chief of the General Staff of the Kuwaiti army, Lt. Gen. Khaled bin Saleh Al-Sabah, received on Monday, Aug.30, 2021, at the Kuwaiti General Staff Headquarters, IMCTC Secretary-General, Maj. Gen. Mohammed bin Saeed Al-Moghedi.

Over the course of the meeting Lt. Gen. Al-Sabah was briefed on IMCTC efforts in counterterrorism and its role in coordinating and intensifying member countries efforts as well as exploring avenues of joint cooperation between the Islamic Military Counterterrorism Coalition and the State of Kuwait on matters of mutual interest.
